

This makes a 12 " block.

## **Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block



To make the needed 3-1/2"squares you will need a 14 " x 3-1/2" strip of each color. Stack these together, and then using a rotary cutter, cut into four 3-1/2" squares of each


Using a rotary cutter, cut them on the diagonal, being careful not to stretch fabrics. With right sides together, sew Color 1 and Color 3 triangles together, using a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Press seam allowances towards darker fabric...


Now piece the squares as shown at the left, sewing four horizontal rows using $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seams. Join the resulting rows and there you have it!
